

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTION NO. 24

Vigilance Directorate during investigation of one of the global tenders have observed certain deficiencies in the tender processing. To overcome shortcomings / deficiencies and avoid recurrence of the same, it is enjoined upon all concerned that meticulous and careful attention be paid for transparency in the procurement process with regard to following:-

- (i) NIT should clearly indicate the type of products required to be shown by the vendors for pre-qualification on the ground of experience to ensure that there is no ambiguity and scope for interpretation with respect to the item / product being procured.
- (ii) NIT should clearly spell out the protocol for the tests to be carried out for technical qualification and the same should be carried out in front of representatives of the tenderers and the results obtained be signed by them.
- (iii) Notes circulated to WAB / PAB / CAB for approvals should be signed on each page including annexures for authentication by the concerned DGM level officer.
